This is an application for a group of five or more teachers to be included in the ICTS NOF training programme.

ICTS is the only "Severe and Complex" provider working in all four home countries. We hope to accommodate everyone who selects our training, but with 4,000 teachers registered already, the choice of available dates will be increasingly restricted.

This application represents a commitment by you that the number of teachers, advisory staff or LSAs specified in this application begin the training between now and May 2002.

On acceptance of your application, one of the ICTS organisations will begin to plan your programme of training with you. This will include the date for delivery of distance learning materials, the first school training day and the final school training day, plus the choice of optional network days available to your staff.

ICTS will provide you with a statement of the final cost of the training (which differs in each of the home countries). The payment plan stipulated by NOF is as follows:

ICTS acceptance of your application: 30% of cost

Final school training day: 70% of cost

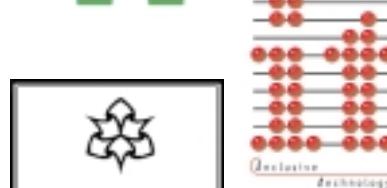
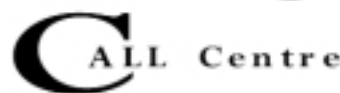
**Who should apply?** As you can see from the organisations making up this syndicate, we are focusing on the severe and complex end of "severe and complex SEN". All of the mainstream providers have a special needs responsibility which should cover the ICT outcomes required for teachers dealing with behavioural difficulties, moderate learning difficulties and specific learning difficulties. It is where the barriers to learning go beyond this that our training will be most valuable.

**As soon as you are registered** your staff will be able to take full advantage of our online resources and conferencing. They will be able to order their sets of distance learning units to enable them to plan their training and apply for places at the various networking days taking place all over Britain and Northern Ireland. Your school will also be able to take advantage of the special discounts available from Inclusive Technology.

If after consulting our brochure and the NOF "Red Book" you feel that our training would be relevant to five or more of the teachers in your school or service (even if you will not be able to start before 2002!), you should apply to register on the form overleaf.
